The Webster Geneva Campus will host the 2026 edition of **Global Game Jam Geneva**, taking place from January 30 to February 1, 2026.

Global Game Jam (GGJ) is the world's largest collaborative game creation event, bringing together tens of thousands of participants across hundreds of locations worldwide. Over the course of 48 hours, participants form teams to design and develop playable game prototypes based on a theme revealed at the start of the event.

Following the success of the 2025 edition, Global Game Jam Geneva 2026 aims to further strengthen the local and international game development community by fostering creativity, collaboration, and experimentation.
